ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

Adverbs of frequency answers the question "How often"

Here are some adverbs of frequency.

- \rm Always
- Hever.
- Generally / usually
- **4** Sometimes / occasionally.

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- ♣ Often / frequently
- Seldon / rarely

Adverbs of frequency (one word) are usually placed beafore the main verb or after the verb to be.

- The baby <u>seldom</u> cries at night.
- I don't <u>usually</u> come home until the evening.
- Do you <u>always</u> study so late?
- We <u>often</u> go to basketball games.
- She isn't <u>often at home</u>.

Heare are some frequency phrases

- \downarrow All the time.
- Every day
- ♣ Five times a week
- 4 On Tuesdays.
- Once a week.
- 4 Almost never.

Frequency phrases (more than one Word) are usually placed at the end of the sentence.

- Henry is on a diet. He eats twice a day.
- I go to the cinema <u>once a month.</u>
- She leaves early <u>several times</u> a week.

Frequency phrases and some frequency words (sometimes, usually, ocasionally) can be placed at the beginning of the sentences for emphasis.

- <u>Once a week</u>, they meet for coffee.
- <u>Sometimes</u> he comes in to see how I am.
- <u>Usually</u> I pay for the dinner.

Mother's Day is <u>always</u> in the spring. I <u>usually</u> give my morther flowers together with a poem. We <u>often</u> go out for lunch on that day but <u>sometimes</u> we go out in the evening instead. I <u>never</u> forget Mother's Day beacause I enjoy it as much as my mother does.
