**ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY**

Adverbs of frequency answers the question “How often”

Here are some adverbs of frequency.

-  Always
-  Never.
-  Generally / usually
-  Sometimes / occasionally.

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- ✚ Often / frequently
- ✚ Seldom / rarely

Adverbs of frequency ( one word) are usually placed beafore the main verb or after the verb to be.

- The baby seldom cries at night.
- I don't usually come home until the evening.
- Do you always study so late?
- We often go to basketball games.
- She isn't often at home.

Heare are some frequency phrases

- ✚ All the time.
- ✚ Every day
- ✚ Five times a week
- ✚ On Tuesdays.
- ✚ Once a week.
- ✚ Almost never.

Frequency phrases (more than one Word) are usually placed at the end of the sentence.

- Henry is on a diet. He eats twice a day.
- I go to the cinema once a month.
- She leaves early several times a week.

Frequency phrases and some frequency words (sometimes, usually, ocasionally) can be placed at the beginning of the sentencesfor emphasis.

- Once a week, they meet for coffee.
- Sometimes he comes in to see how I am.
- Usually I pay for the dinner.

Mother's Day is always in the spring. I usually give my morthor flowers together with a poem. We often go out for lunch on that day but sometimes we go out in the evening instead. I never forget Mother's Day beacause I enjoy it as much as my mother does.
