Ejemplos forma **afirmativa** para los pronombres **I, You, We** o **They**

* **I have got** a dog (Yo tengo un perro)

Cuando hablamos de los pronombres **He, She, It** el verbo '**have got**' cambia a '**Has got**'

* **She has got** a dog (Ella tiene un perro)

Ejemplos forma **negativa**: * **I haven't got** a cat

* **She hasn't got** a cat

Para armar **preguntas**, el pronombre va en el medio del **have/has got**

* **Have you got** a parrot?

* **Has she got** a parrot?
