THE PASSIVE VOICE

El Pasivo en Inglés

Usamos la forma pasiva para enfatizar la acción en vez de quién lo hizo. Se forma el pasivo con una forma del verbo to be y el participio. El verbo to be tiene que estar en la forma del tiempo de la oración (presente, pasado, etc.).

IMPORTANTE

En pasiva los verbos siempre deben ir en participio, es decir, que si el verbo es irregular le corresponde su forma en la 3° columna, (buy /bought). En caso de los verbos regulares
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se les agrega ed, (PLAYED) pero si el verbo termina con E solo se le agrega D (LIVE/ LIVED) Si termina en CONSONANTE + Y, se reemplaza la Y quedando IES, (STUDY/ STUDIES), consonante + vocal +consonante duplica la última consonante (STOP/ STOPPED)
