Ella tiene el pelo negro. She has got black hair.

Ella tiene un auto . She has got a car.

Sentences (oraciones)

Affirmative: sujeto + have/has got + complement

Interrogative: Have/Has + sujeto +got + complement + ?

Negative: Sujeto + have/ has got + complement.

| You have got | You haven't got. | Have you got? |
| They have got. | They haven't got. | Have they got? |
