


From Ecuador to Argentina.



How are you doing? So you want more information about my trip to Machu Picchu, eh? Here it is:

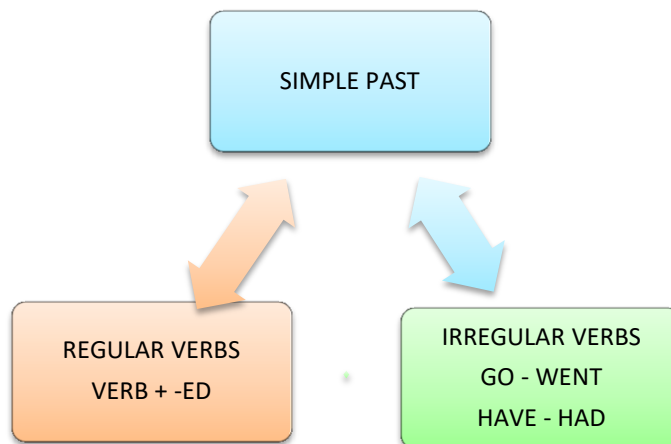
