Forma larga

Forma corta

I am not in Spain.	= I' m not in Spain.
You are not in Paris.	= You aren't in Paris.
He is not in London.	= He isn't in London.
She is not in Rome.	= She isn't in Rome.
It is not in Brazil.	= It isn't in Brazil.
They are not in Rio.	= They aren't in Rio.
We are not in Japan.	= We aren't in Japan.
