PRESENTE SIMPLE NEGATIVO	
Sin contraer	Contraído
I do not play	I don't play
You do not play	You don't play
He does not play	He doesn't play
She does not play	She doesn't play
It does not play	It doesn't play
We do not play	We don't play
You do not play	You don't play
They do not play	They don't play

- Para hacer una oración negativa, debemos usar un verbo especial (do o does):

DOES + NOT + INFINITIVO/ DOESN'T + INFINITIVO:

para la tercera persona del singular:

She does not go to the cinema every Saturday.

He doesn't go to the cinema every Saturday.

DO + NOT + INFINITIVO/ DON'T + INFINITIVO:

para el resto de personas:

I do not go to the cinema every Saturday.

We don't go to the cinema every Saturday.
