1) Grammar: **VERB "TO BE":** Negative

CONTRACCIONES NEGATIVAS DEL VERBO "TO BE"			
CONJUGACIÓN NEG.:	CONTRACCIONES VÁLIDAS:		TRADUCCIÓN:
I am not	I'm not		(Yo) no soy / (Yo) no estoy
You are not	You're not	You aren't	(Tú) no eres / (Tú) no estás
He is not	He's not	He isn't	(El) no es / (El) no está
She is not	She's not	She isn't	(Ella) no es / (Ella) no está
It is not	It's not	It isn't	No es / No está Cosas o animales
We are not	We're not	We aren't	(Nos.) no somos / (Nos.) no estamos
You are not	You're not	You aren't	(Uds.) no son / (Uds.) no están
They are not	They're not	They aren't	(Ellos) no son / (Ellos) no están

Examples: I am not a doctor. (Yo no soy doctor)

You are not in the cinema. (tú no estás en el cine)

She isn't a nurse. (ella no es una enfermera)

We are not in the school (nosotros no estamos en la escuela)

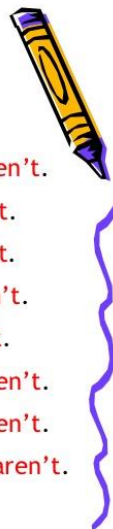

VERB "TO BE" (ser o estar)

Interrogative form / Short answers

Am I ...?	Yes, you are . / No, you aren't .
Are you ...?	Yes, I am . / No, I'm not .
Is he ...?	Yes, he is . / No, he isn't .
Is she ...?	Yes, she is . / No, she isn't .
Is it ...?	Yes, it is . / No, it isn't .
Are we ...?	Yes, we are . / No, we aren't .
Are you ...?	Yes, we are . / No, we aren't .
Are they ...?	Yes, they are . / No, they aren't .



Example: Are they your parents? (¿Son tus padres?)

Yes, they are ---- No, they aren't

Is your mother a teacher? (¿Es tu madre una maestra?)

Yes, she is ----- No, she isn't.

Am I wrong? (¿Estoy equivocado?)
Yes, you are ----- No, you aren't
