PRESENT SIMPLE

FORMA NEGATIVA

Estructura:

SUJETO + DO/DOES + NOT+ VERBO + COMPLEMENTOS
Contraída: SUJETO + DON'T/DOESN'T + VERBO + COMPLEMENTOS

Singular

I do not write

You do not write

He **does** not write (NO ES *he does not writes*)

She **does** not write

It **does** not write

They do not write

We do not write

Plural

We do not write

You do not write

They do not write

Negativa contraída:

I do not write -----> I don't write

You do not write -----> You don't write

He does not write -----> He doesn't write

She does not write -----> She doesn't write

It does not write -----> It doesn't write

We do not write -----> We don't write

You do not write -----> You don't write

They do not write -----> They don't write

FORMA INTERROGATIVA:

Estructura:

DO/DOES+SUJETO+VERBO+COMPLEMENTOS

En las preguntas, el auxiliar do o does siempre va al principio de la frase, antes del sujeto. Recuerda: does se usa para he, she y it:

Con las preguntas pasa lo mismo que con las negaciones: con he, she y it el verbo principal no lleva s, y has se convierte en have.

Do I play tennis? Yes, I do / No, I don't.

Does he play tennis? Yes, he does / No, he doesn't.

Does she play tennis? Yes, she does / No, she doesn't.

Does it play? Yes, it does / No, it doesn't.

Do they play tennis? Yes, they do / No, they don't.

Do we play tennis? Yes, we do / No, we don't.
