Los adjetivos posesivos en inglés son los que nos ayudan a expresar de quién es algo o a quién pertenece esto o aquello. En inglés se usan muchísimo más que en castellano y van delante del sustantivo.

**My** car is blue.

**His** cap is new.

Debemos tener cuidado con el adjetivo “its” con la contracción de pronombre y verbo ser “it’s”. **Its** es menos común porque normalmente hablamos de personas que hacen cosas. Pero a veces algo sin género hace algo también.

Un par de ejemplos: The tree is losing **its** leaves = El árbol está perdiendo **sus** hojas.

The dog is wagging **its** tail = El perro está moviendo **su** cola.
