Grammar: Adverbs of frequency

- Los adverbios de frecuencia se utilizan para decir con qué continuidad hacemos algo.
- Estos adverbios son: **always** (siempre), **usually** (usualmente), **often** (a menudo), **sometimes** (a veces), **hardly ever** (casi nunca), **never** (nunca).
- La estructura de la oración es: **SUJETO/ ADVERBIO DE FRECUENCIA/ VERBO**
Ejemplo: She always plays tennis on Mondays.
- Cuando en la oración se utiliza el verbo to be (am, is, are) la estructura es: **SUJETO/ VERBO TO BE/ ADVERBIO DE FRECUENCIA/**
Ejemplo: She is always late.
- Usamos la pregunta **HOW OFTEN...?** Para preguntar con qué frecuencia alguien hace algo. Ejemplo: How often do you play football?
