Object Pronouns

Uso: los pronombres personales en inglés se utilizan para sustituir la parte de la frase que ya es conocida, ya sea sujeto u objeto.

Recuerda!! A diferencia del español , el sujeto en inglés no se puede omitir (a menos que nos refiramos a frases imperativas).

Los Object Pronouns siempre van detrás del verbo

They have it (Ellos lo tienen)

El **Object Pronoun** siguen a las preposiciones

You talk to you (Ustedes hablan con ellos)

You	you
He	him
She + verb.	verb + her
It	it
We	us
They	them
