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AFFIRMATIVE FORM

Reglas de los verbos regulares:

Con la mayoría de los verbos, se añade -ed al infinitive sin to. Play - play**ed**

Con verbos acabados en -e, se añade -d. Love - love**d**

Con verbos acabados en consonante, vocal, consonante, la consonante se duplica y se añade -ed.

Stop - stop**ped**

Nota: las ultimas cuatro consonantes del abc no se duplican. **w, x, y, z.**

Con verbos acabados en consonante e **Y**, se cambia la **Y** por **I** y se añade -ed.

Study - stud**ied**
