PAST FORM OF “TO BE”

was/were is the past form of am/is/are

- I **am** an engineer.
- I **was** an engineer ten years ago.
- She **is** at home today.
- She **was** at home yesterday.
- The armchairs **are** quite comfortable.
- The armchairs **were** quite comfortable.



Traducción de las oraciones del anteriores

- ° Yo **soy** un ingeniero. / Yo **era** un ingeniero hace 10 años.
- ° Ella **está** en la casa / Ella **estuvo** en la casa ayer.
- ° Las sillas **son** bastantes confortables/ Las sillas **eran** bastante confortables.

Forma afirmativa y negativa del verbo “ to Be”

WAS - WERE TO BE - Past Tense							
AFFIRMATIVE			NEGATIVE				
I	was	happy.	I	wasn't	sad.	wasn't = was not	
He	was	hungry.	He	wasn't	thirsty.		
She	was	a nurse.	She	wasn't	a teacher.		
It	was	big.	It	wasn't	small.		
We	were	early.	We	weren't	late.	weren't = were not	
You	were	at school.	You	weren't	at home.		
They	were	quiet.	They	weren't	noisy.

Uso del To Be en Pasado – Was/ Were

Las palabras “was” y “were” pueden tener 4 significados.

- Los primeros dos significados se relacionan con el verbo ESTAR y funcionan para todos los pronombres personales:

She **was** here yesterday (ella estuvo / estaba aquí ayer)
En este caso “**was**” puede significar “estuvo” o “estaba”.

- Los segundos dos significados se relacionan con el verbo SER y funcionan para todos los pronombres personales:

They **were** happy in their childhood (ellos eran / fueron felices en su niñez)

En este caso “**were**” puede significar “eran” o “fueron”.
