He **has got** a dog.
She **has got** a dog.
It **has got** a kennel.
We **have got** a dog.
They **have got** a dog.

Este verbo lo usamos para indicar que algo nos pertenece. Significa "TENER" y solo tiene 2 formas! Have got (para I, you, we y they) y has got (he, she, it)
