Lo utilizo para acciones que comenzaron y finalizaron.	Lo uso para acciones que estaban en progreso en el pasado hasta que otra acción las interrumpió.
La acción es más corta.	La acción es más larga
Utilizo “when” al principio de la oración o en el medio.	Utilizo “while” al principio de la oración o en el medio.
<u>When</u> my dad <u>arrived</u> .	I <u>was listening</u> to music.
(Cuando mi papa llego,	Yo estaba escuchando musica.”
My dad arrived	While I was listening to music.
