The Indefinite Articles A and An (los artículos indefinidos "A" y "An")

Use: The Indefinite Articles **a** and **an** are used before a **singular countable noun**.

A is used:

- In front of a noun or adjective beginning with a **consonant**, the **letter y** or the **letter u** if it is pronounced **[iu]**.

Examples: a mouse – a yellow bird - a uniform

An is used:

- In front of a noun or adjective beginning with a **vowel** or a **silent h**.

Examples: an umbrella – an apple – an hour
