What are you going to study?	¿Qué vas a estudiar?

Yes, I'm going to study Spanish.	Sí, voy a estudiar español.
Are you going to learn anything?	¿Vas a aprender algo?

EL VERBO "TO BE" + GOING TO + EL VERBO PRINCIPAL EN INFINITIVO.

EJEMPLO: I AM GOING TO STUDY ENGLISH.

SHE IS GOING TO WASH THE CAR.

THEY ARE GOING TO TRAVEL TO SPAIN.
