Positive, Negative, Interrogative



POSITIVE:

I, you, we, they: bare infinitive he, she, it: bare infinitive + -s E.g.:

I **drink** milk every day. He **dink**<u>s</u> milk every day.

NEGATIVE:

I, you, we, they: don't + bare infinitive he, she, it: doesn't + bare infinitive.
F.a:

I <u>don't</u> drink milk every day. He <u>doesn't</u> drink milk every day.

INTERROGATIVE:

Do + I/ you/we/ they + bare infinitive

Does + he/she/it + bare infinitive

E.g.:

<u>Do</u> I drink milk every day? <u>Does</u> he drink milk every day?


