Estructura: Sujeto + Have/ Has got + resto de la oración.

- YOU HAVE GOT A RADIO
- HE HAS GOT A DOG
- SHE HAS GOT A CAT
- IT HAS GOT A BALL
- WE HAVE GOT A BIG FAMILY
- THEY HAVE GOT TWO BROTHERS.

UTILIZAMOS HAS GOT CON LOS  
SUJETOS:

HE, SHE , IT.

¡FORMA NEGATIVA!

Estructura: Sujeto+ Have/Has NOT got+ resto de la oración.

- I HAVE NOT GOT A BICYCLE
- YOU HAVE NOT GOT A RADIO
- HE HAS NOT GOT A DOG
- SHE HAS NOT GOT A CAT
- IT HAS NOT GOT A BALL
- WE HAVE NOT GOT A BIG FAMILY
- THEY HAVE NOT GOT TWO BROTHERS



¡FORMA INTERROGATIVA!

Estructura: **Have/has + Sujeto + got + resto de la oración?**


