She sleeps	She does not sleep
It sleeps	It doesn't sleep
We sleep	We do not sleep
You sleep	You don't sleep
They sleep	They don't sleep

INTERROGATIVE	SHORT ANSWERS

Does she sleep ...?	Yes, she does . / No, she doesn't .
