Usamos "Past Continuous" para referirnos a acciones que estaban sucediendo en un momento específico del pasado. Por ejemplo: "Yesterday at 6 o'clock I was sleeping" (Ayer a las 6 yo estaba durmiendo)

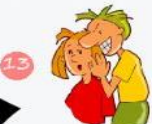

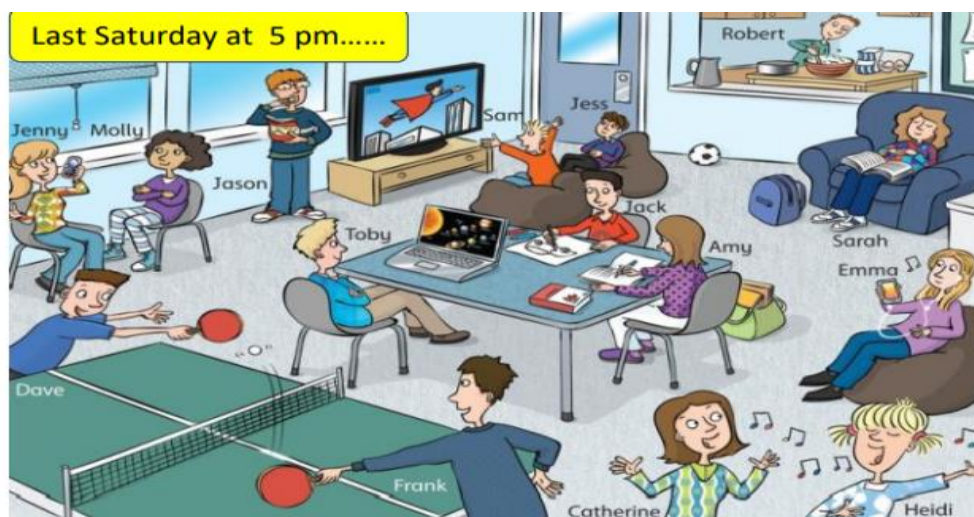
