It's one o'clock.= It's one a.m. (or p.m.)

Es la una en punto= es la una a.m.

It's five past one= It's one (oh) five (a.m. or p.m.)

Es la una y cinco= es la una y cinco

It's quarter past one.= It's one fifteen (a.m. or p.m.)

Es la una y cuarto = es la una y quince

It's half past one.= It's one thirty (a.m. or p.m.)

Es la una y media = es la una y treinta

It's twenty to one.= It's twelve forty (a.m. or p.m.)

Es la una menos veinte = son las doce cuarenta
