

I am (I'm)	I am not (I'm not)
You are (You're)	You are not (You aren't)
He is (He's)	He is not (He isn't)
She is (She's)	She is not (She isn't)
It is (It's)	It is not (It isn't)
We are (We're)	We are not (We aren't)
You are (You're)	You are not (You aren't)
They are (They're)	They are not (They aren't)

Remember!

Use **he** for a man or boy. Use **she** for a woman or girl. Use **it** for an object, animal or place. **They** is the plural form of **he**, **she** and **it**.
