### **Capacidades a desarrollar :**

#### **Comprensión lectora.**

- ✓ Utilizar las expresiones gramaticales propias del tiempo verbal (auxiliares) en la resolución de actividades.
- ✓ Transformación de un tipo de oración a otro.

#### Desarrollo:

Las oraciones Afirmativas que ya aprendimos además de tener un orden tenían diferencia al momento de escribir el verbo si el sujeto es tercera persona por ejemplo:

He gets up every morning.	I get up every morning.
He watches tv.	They watch tv.

Sin embargo si las transformamos en oraciones Negativas e Interrogativas, deberíamos agregarles Auxiliar.

El Auxiliar puede ser **Do/Does** dependiendo del sujeto de la oración y no tiene traducción en Español, pero no debe faltar en este tipo de oraciones en Inglés. Al usar el auxiliar el verbo se escribe en forma infinitiva (es decir sin **s /es**).
