**Simple past irregular verbs:** en la presente guía le daremos continuidad a la guía 4. En esta guía estudiaremos el pasado de verbos irregulares. Estos, (a diferencia de los regulares que agregan “ed” al infinitivo o verbo base) al formar el pasado:

- cambian completamente su escritura y pronunciación, por ejemplo: **go – went**, el verbo to be: **am- is** → **was**, **are** → **were**.

- Cambian solo su pronunciación: **read /ri:d/** → **read/red/**

- O no cambian ni escritura ni pronunciación, por ejemplo: **cut** → **cut**

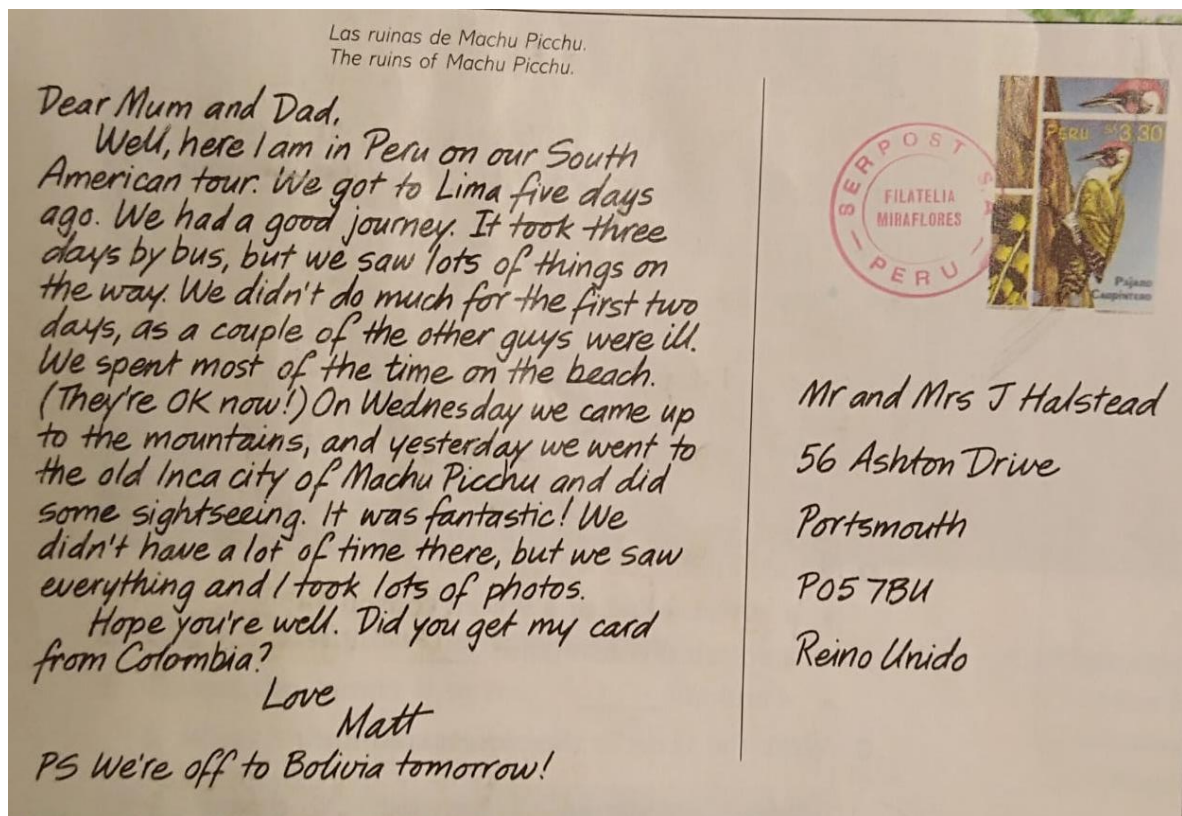
