

Frida Kahlo: her biography

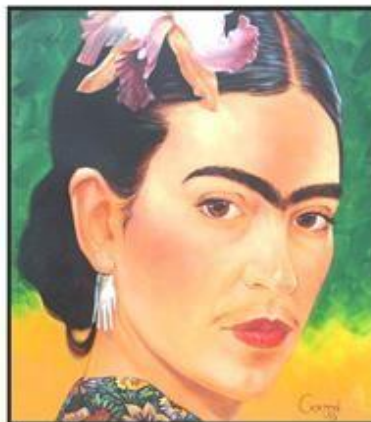
