Rules for Plural Nouns

Most nouns add **s** to form plural

Nouns that end with sh, ch, x, z, or s add **es**

Nouns end with vowel + y, add **s**

Nouns end with consonant + y, change y to i and add **es**

Nouns that end with f or fe, change f or fe to ves

Nouns end with vowel + o, add **s**

Nouns end with consonant + o, add **es**
