IMMEDIATE FUTURE:

Positive	Negative
I am going to	I am not going to
You are going to	You are not going to
He is going to	He is not going to
She is going to	She is not going to
It is going to	It is not going to
We are going to	We are not going to
You are going to	You are not going to
They are going to	They are not going to

Como ves, formar la forma inmediata del futuro es sencillo: se usa AM, IS, ARE, y luego GOING TO, y luego el verbo sin agregarle nada.

EJEMPLO:

“I am going to play soccer” (VOY A jugar al fútbol).

Aquí te dejamos algunos ejemplos:

Form: Be going to					
Subject	am/is/are		Going to	Verb	
I	am	not	going to	open	the door.
You	are		going to	meet	Jane tonight.
He	is		going to	be	at school tomorrow.
She	is	not	going to	clean	the floor.
It	is		going to	be	there tomorrow.
They	are	not	going to	make	dinner.
We	are		going to	make	some sandwiches.

When asking a question					
Are	You		going to	meet	Jane tonight?
Is	he	not	going to	do	his homework?

Para preguntar:

Para PREGUNTAR, intercambiamos el verbo BE (o sea, AM, IS, ARE) con la persona o sujeto.

EJEMPLO: En vez de Tom is....→ Is Tom...?

Is Tom going to study today? (¿Va a estudiar Tom hoy?)

What is Tom going to study today? (¿Qué va a estudiar Tom hoy?)
