Do you remember the form of simple present?

The simple present is used to talk routines.

We used Do and Does in negative and interrogative form.

We add **S** or **ES** in affirmative when we used She, It or He.

1. Write a text about your daily routine, read and review the previous guides.

Debemos recordar que el presente simple se usa para hablar de hábitos y rutinas diarias.

Recuerda que en las oraciones afirmativas que cuando usamos He, She o It le agregamos S o Es al verbo según las reglas dadas en las guías anteriores.

En las oraciones interrogativas y negativas usamos el auxiliar DO o DOES según el sujeto. Para HE, SHE o IT DOES, y para YOU, WE o THEY DO.

Para completar oraciones podemos usar los adverbios de frecuencia que van ubicados detrás del verbo. Recuerda algunos: always, never, sometimes, often, usually, etc....

También podemos usar partes del día (in the morning, in the afternoon....), podemos usar la hora (at nine o'clock....) or los días (on Monday).
