INTERROGATIVE FORM (FORMA INTERROGATIVA)

HAVE GOT INTERROGATIVE

QUESTIONS	SHORT ANSWERS
Have I got?	Yes, I/you have
Have you got?	No, I/you haven't
Has he got?	Yes, he/she/it has
Has she got?	No, he/she/it hasn't
Has it got?	
Have we got?	Yes, we/you/they have
Have you got?	No, we/you/they haven't
Have they got?
