

Verb to be: Affirmative & negative forms

<i>I am (I'm)</i>	<i>I am not (I'm not)</i>
<i>You are (You're)</i>	<i>You are not (You aren't)</i>
<i>He is (He's)</i>	<i>He is not (He isn't)</i>
<i>She is (She's)</i>	<i>She is not (She isn't)</i>
<i>It is (It's)</i>	<i>It is not (It isn't)</i>
<i>We are (We're)</i>	<i>We are not (We aren't)</i>
<i>You are (You're)</i>	<i>You are not (You aren't)</i>
<i>They are (They're)</i>	<i>They are not (They aren't)</i>

Remember!
 Use *he* for a man or boy. Use *she* for a woman or girl. Use *it* for an object, animal or place. *They* is the plural form of *he, she* and *it*.

Useful Tip > Grammar
 We use *and* to join two words, phrases or ideas.
Maths and Geography aren't easy.
Mike and Sulley are university students.
